






# AFFORDING A ST. ANNE-PACELLI EDUCATION

# TUITION & FEES



The tuition & fees outlined below are in effect for the 2024-2025 school year. Typically, tuition is raised 3% each year, though every effort is made to keep tuition at the lowest amount possible, while continuing to employ quality teachers and provide resources for students.

Tuition includes a yearbook, school t-shirt (new students only), books, admission to regular season home athletic events and daily lunch for grades Pre-K4 through 12. SAGE Dining Services provides our school community with a wide variety of delicious, dietitian approved, cooked from scratch meal choices with unlimited seconds.

#### Other Fees & Discounts

- Application for Admission Fee: \$50 per student, non-refundable (new students only)
- Registration Fee: \$250 per student, \$500 per family maximum
- Athletic Facilities Fee: \$100 per family grades PreK-4 through 12
- Home & School Association Fee: \$20 per family
- Chromebook (without case): \$250 per student for new students in grades 5-12
- Sibling Discount: \$300 per year for each additional student
- High School Dues: \$25 per student for students in grade 11 only
- Graduation Fee: \$75 per student for students in grade 12 only

#### Payment Plans

All tuition payments and fees are invoiced and collected through FACTS. FACTS charges an annual \$50 fee for processing payments. Payment options are:

- Payment in full: There is a 3% discount for tuition paid in full by June 30, 2024. The \$50 FACTS processing fee is also waived.
- Monthly or Bi-Monthly Payments: Payments are automatic drafts June 2024-May 2025 once or twice a month.

#### **Extended Day**

Extended Day provides safe, supervised after-school care for students in PK3 through 8th grade from 3-6 p.m. An after-school snack is provided. Monthly attendees enjoy a \$25 discount for each additional child enrolled.

- \$40 Registration Fee
- Monthly Rate: \$165 per month per student (December is billed at \$100; no sibling discount in December)
- Daily Drop-In Rate:
  - \$17/day. Drop-ins are limited to 4 days per month. Any student exceeding four days will be charged \$97 for day 5 and an additional \$17 for days 6-31.
  - \$6/hour for student-athletes in grades 5-8 participating in an in-season sport; unlimited drop-ins.


# **SCHOLARSHIPS**

St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School is blessed to be able to offer a variety of financial assistance. The following non-needs based financial assistance exists:

- Parish Scholarships: In order to receive a parish scholarship, families must be active and registered in their Columbus-area Catholic parish. Parish scholarship applications can be found online here <a href="https://www.beaviking.com/tuition-and-affordability">www.beaviking.com/tuition-and-affordability</a> and must be received by February 9, 2024 to be considered for the Parish Scholarship. Families who are new to the area should provide a letter from their previous parish indicating they were registered and active.
- <u>St. Anne-Pacelli Scholarships:</u> Scholarships are intended to reward students for academic and other achievements. Families are not required to fill out the FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment to apply for scholarships. The final scholarship application deadline for the 2024-2025 school year is January 31, 2024. Review the scholarship descriptions, found online here <u>www.beaviking.com/scholarships--awards</u> and complete a scholarship application by January 31, 2024.
- <u>Georgia Special Needs Scholarship:</u> Students residing in Georgia who have an IEP or 504 plan may qualify for the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship program. Please visit <u>www.gadoe.org</u> for eligibility information and the scholarship amount calculator.
- <u>Folds of Honor Scholarship:</u> The Folds of Honor organization offers scholarships for children of service members who were killed in action, missing in action, Purple Heart recipients or 90 -100% disabled due to military service. They also make awards to children of first responders who were killed or disabled. The applications open February 1st and deadline in March. For eligibility and applications, visit <u>www.foldsofhonor.org/scholarships</u>.

### Did you know?

Up to \$10,000 of private school tuition each year may be paid out of a 529 Savings Plan. This is great way to pay tuition and save on taxes. Please consult your tax advisor or 529 Plan for more information.





## **TUITION ASSISTANCE**

To be considered for needs-based tuition assistance, students must be accepted for admission and families must complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment at

https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3CDW1. FACTS is a well-established, third-party service that keeps financial information private and secure. They calculate a family's ability to pay on behalf of St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School. When you apply in FACTS, you will be asked to upload financial information. Typically they will ask for copies of your 2022 Federal Income Tax Return and 2023 W-2s. If you do not file federal taxes, you may indicate that in the FACTS application.

Once the FACTS application is complete and the information verified by the tax documents, a report is provided to St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School for review by the Tuition Assistance Committee. FACTS will send an email notification once a tuition assistance award is made by the Tuition Assistance Committee.

We make every effort to meet a family's demonstrated financial need; however, we are not able to make full-tuition awards. The priority deadline for applying for tuition assistance is March 1, 2024. After that date, applications for aid are subject to funds availability. The FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment must be completed each year. Students may receive both scholarship and tuition assistance awards.

Families who receive needs-based tuition assistance are required to contribute 20 hours of volunteer service to the school during the school year in which the assistance is received.
