St. Anne-Pacelli is a college preparatory, preschool through 12th grade, Catholic school dedicated to giving children these opportunities and more.







Learn is a verb and should be active. It's more than multiple choice questions and memorization. To be successful, students need to develop the ability to think critically, solve problems creatively and communicate confidently. St. Anne-Pacelli develops these skills in students using a college preparatory curriculum taught by experienced, licensed teachers. Smaller classes allow for more interactive lessons and group activities.

Students take English, Math, Science and Religion each year. A minimum of three Social Studies, two Foreign Language, one Fine Arts and one PE/Health class are required for graduation.
Honors, pre-AP and AP classes are available for students ready for more challenge. The AP Capstone and Global Competency Seal programs help students set themselves apart by completing additional course and project work for a special diploma designation.
