Dear Parents,

The last MAP test that your St. Anne-Pacelli student took was this past winter. We usually take this test in the spring, as well, but due to the pandemic we were not able to do so. The MAP test is just one assessment that shows how well a student is progressing.

MAP is correlated to Khan Academy, a website that allows students to practice areas where they may have weaknesses. This summer, your student will access Khan Academy to complete his/her summer homework.

To use Khan Academy,

1. Visit khanacademy.org/mappers.
2. You will be prompted to enter your child's RIT scores for each of the Math sub-areas. In the drop-down menu, select "Mathematics 2-5." *Note: RIT scores will be included with your student's final 2019-2020 St. Anne-Pacelli report card; if you are a new family, please email 4th grade teacher [Mrs. Archer](#) for details about how to accomplish Math summer homework.*
3. Once you enter the individual scores, click "show me the recommendations." The program will give you practice problems in the areas that your child needs reinforcement and growth. The links will show up in blue. Click each of these links to practice.
4. Helpful hint: In the browser window where the exercise opened, you may copy the Web address URL so you can go directly back into the practice area without having to re-enter the RIT scores.

This is a great way to keep students growing academically during the summer!
